## General Information



	Plant	Soil
Sample Amount	Depending upon test, 200g of fresh material or 5g dried plant material if the sample is prepared.	Depending upon tests, 500g per sample if samples are not prepared.
Packaging	Any paper bag. Please do not use plastic bags.	Zip-lock or resealable bag, properly sealed. Remove excess air from the bag and press to seal.
Labelling Samples	Please make sure that all sample bags are labelled properly and clearly. All samples from outside WA must be clearly labelled QUARANTINE MATERIAL on the outside of the packaging. If samples are being analysed for soil moisture, health or bioassay testing please label the postage bag/box clearly for the test required so proper handling procedures can be carried out.	
Paperwork	Please fill out the CSBP Plant/Soil Request form and send with your samples. Please keep a copy for your own reference.  OR Please attached your own paperwork with your samples providing the following information: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Your name/Trading name and contact details (phone, fax, address, etc)</li> <li>• Account details, payment details and purchase order number if required</li> <li>• An email address to send the results to (or fax/post if preferred)</li> <li>• What tests you require on all the samples and if the samples are prepared</li> </ul>	
Despatching Samples	If posting, it is recommended you send samples using express postage so you can keep track of the samples.

Customers must prepare and grind any samples containing glass and/or rubbish before CSBP Soil and Plant Laboratory accept them.

All samples prepared by customers that contained glass and/or rubbish must be clearly labelled 'Hazardous'.

CSBP Soil and Plant Laboratory will not carry out texturing or total nitrogen analysis on any samples containing glass and/or rubbish. The risk to staff carrying out these tests are too high.

Manure and compost samples are best analysed with the Plant Basic test which measures total amounts of macro and micro nutrients. Please DO NOT submit manures or composts for a soil test, unless specific soil properties are required.

CSBP LABORATORY DOES NOT ANALYSE FERTILISER SAMPLES.

### Samples to be kept or returned?

Samples are discarded 3 months after the completion of analysis.

If you would like your samples to be returned to you instead of being discarded, please indicate on your paperwork that you would like your samples to be kept for eventual return. Once you have received your analysis report and are satisfied with the data, please contact us with information on how and where you would like us to send the samples.

It is YOUR responsibility to organise the return of your samples within 3 months or they will be discarded. Also consider that this will be at your own expense. The laboratory is not liable for any missing or lost samples.
